## What to bring:

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

including motor oil, gasoline, antifreeze, mercury, kerosene, acids, aerosols, fluorescent bulbs, lawn/garden chemicals, lead acid batteries, smoke detectors, glues & adhesives, hobby chemicals, misc. cleaners and corrosives

### ELECTRONICS

including televisions, computers, hard drives, laptops, keyboards, printers, mice, fax machines, phones, scanners, tablets, monitors, and misc. cables and cords

### PAINT

including spray paint, latex paint, oil-based paint, caulk, stain, and varnish

## DOCUMENT SHREDDING DAY

Thursday, May 20	2 pm to 6 pm
Tuesday, October 5	2 pm to 6 pm

## What to bring:

Up to two boxes of paper documents per person for confidential on-site shredding

## HOUSEHOLD Special Waste Program Rules:

Proof of Residency required  
No farms, schools or businesses  
No containers over 5 gallons  
Containers will not be returned

### Do NOT bring:

CRT tubes removed from televisions  
Explosives or ammunition  
Tires  
Asbestos

Electronics that are not TV or computer related

## SAFE TRANSPORTATION TIPS

Do not mix different chemicals!

Leave substances in their original containers, and make sure caps and/or lids are securely closed. Place containers in sturdy boxes in an upright position.

Never transport leaking or open containers.

## IMPORTANT:

When you make your appointment, please let us know if you have unknown or unlabeled chemicals. Safety is a priority!
