

PROPOSED MINUTES BIRCH RUN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING APRIL 12, 1988

Twenty people were in attendance.

A motion to continue with First of America as depository of township funds was made by Scharrer, supported by Strong. Motion carried.

A motion to reappoint Kevin Lincoln as liquor inspector was made by Strong, supported by Block. Motion carried.

Supervisor reported that Kenneth Hauck wishes to resign from planning commission. A motion to accept the resignation was made by Strong, supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

Supervisor reported on recent meeting he had with Genesee County sewer officials. A motion to authorize Genesee County to conduct a study of our connecting to their system was made by Strong, supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

Supervisor explained Michigan Youth Corps program. Motion by Scharrer and supported by Dorr to accept two youth corps workers for township offices and library. Motion carried.
