

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE  
AND ORDINANCE ADOPTED

At a regular meeting of the Birch Run Township Board, of Birch Run Township, Saginaw County, Michigan, held on the 14th day of September A. D., 1970 at 7:30 o'clock in the evening, at the Township Clerk's office, in Birch Run Township, Saginaw County, Michigan, and the following members being present: Mona J. Totten, Supervisor; Cella Block, Clerk; Herbert Haubenstr. Treasurer; Chilson Ross, Trustee; and Alvin Block, Trustee, it was moved, supported and adopted by a unanimous vote as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Birch Run, pursuant to its power granted by statute, enact the following ordinance, to be known as "Fire Control and Burning Ordinance", and to be identified as Section 1 of Chapter 1 of the ordinances of Birch Run Township, and which shall read as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF BIRCH RUN

CHAPTER 1

Section 1. Fire Control and Burning Ordinance.

1.1 All persons, firms or corporations, living or located within said Township of Birch Run, Saginaw County, Michigan, shall be required to provide suitable receptacles for the burning of trash and rubbish in such a manner as not to create a nuisance by reason of smoke or odor, and without exposing the property surrounding said trash burner or fire container to the hazard of fire.

1.2 Any person causing any grass fire, trash fire or fire of any name, nature or description, which causes damage of any name, nature or description, by burning or otherwise, shall be responsible for said acts; and in addition to the penalty hereinafter provided, shall be responsible for the costs and expenses incurred by said Township for the extinguishing of said fire by the Township Fire Department, or by the fire department of any other governmental unit.

1.3 Any person, firm, corporation or agent thereof who violates or disobeys or takes part in or assists in the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five and 00/100 (\$25.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both such fine, costs and imprisonment, for the first such offense; and upon conviction of a second violation or offense under this said ordinance, such person, firm or corporation shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment for not more than sixty (60) days, or both such fine, costs and imprisonment. Each separate violation of the provisions of...

...this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

1.4 That this ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication of the same in the Birch Run Banner, held on the 11th day of September A. D., 1970 at 7:30 o'clock in the evening, at the Township Clerk's office, in Birch Run Township, Saginaw County, Michigan, and the following: MOBA J. TOTEN, Mayor; J. Toten, Supervisor; Carl E. Supervisor; Herbert Hanbenstrick, Treasurer; Chilson Ross, Trustee; and Alvin Block, Trustee. It was moved, supported and adopted by a unanimous vote as follows:

CHAPTER 1

Section 1. Fire Control and Burning Ordinance.

1.1 All persons, firms or corporations, living or located within said Township of Birch Run, Saginaw County, Michigan, shall be required to provide suitable receptacles for the burning of trash and rubbish in such a manner as not to create a nuisance by reason of smoke or odor, and without exposing the property surrounding said trash burner or fire burner to the hazard of fire.

1.2 Any person causing any grass fire, brush fire or fire of any name, nature or description, which causes damage of any kind, injury or destruction, by burning or otherwise, shall be responsible for said cost; and in addition to the penalty hereinafter provided, shall be responsible for the costs and expenses incurred by said Township for the extinguishing of said fire by the Township Fire Department, or by the fire department of any other governmental unit.

1.3 Any person, firm, corporation or sports hunter who violates or causes or causes part to or assists in the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five (25) dollars (for each violation) and the costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days on each such fine, or both such fine and imprisonment, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and upon conviction of a second violation of this ordinance, such person, firm or corporation shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty (50) dollars (for each violation) and the costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment for not more than sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment, or both separate violation of the ordinance of
